

Meeks Bay Fire Protection District Reorganization LAFCO Project No. 2010-04

The Meeks Bay Fire Protection District Reorganization proposes to annexation of 38 parcels (approximately 1,486 acres): APNs 016-600-04, -07, -08, -10, -13, -19, -20, 21, 017-061-10, 017-081-01, 017-101-01, 017-121-01, 018-011-04, 018-020-01, -02, -03, -04, -05, -06, -07, -08, -09, -10, -11, 018-030-01, -02, -03, -04, -05, -06, -07, -08, -09, -10, -11, -12, -13 and -14 and detachment of 14 parcels (approximately 1,300 acres): APNs 014-021-01, -02, -06, -07, -08, -09, -10, 014-031-01, -02, 016-071-11, -12, -13, 016-121-08 and -11. The reorganization will better align the boundaries of the Meeks Bay Fire Protection District with its service area and first response area. Of the 38 parcels proposed for annexation, 32 are developed with privately owned structures (25 are leased from the US Forest Service) and 6 are undeveloped US Forest Service land. The properties proposed for annexation are located south of the current District boundary to Emerald Bay and in the Rubicon Bay area. The 14 parcels proposed for detachment are undeveloped State and Federally owned lands primarily in the northwestern portion of the District. The US Forest Service and/or CAL FIRE will continue to have responsibility for fire suppression in this area.
