(b) It is desired that the proposed annexation provide for and be made subject to the following terms and conditions: None.

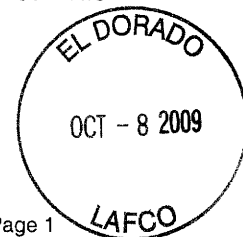

(e) Request is hereby respectfully made that proceedings be undertaken by the El Dorado County Local Agency Formation Commission for the annexation proposed herein.




