RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the Commission note that the original staff report was incorrect in its reporting of the actions taken by the Mosquito FPD Board of Directors and weigh the correction accordingly. Given this new information, however, staff recommends tabling this discussion until a later date.

REASON FOR RECOMMENDED ACTION AND BACKGROUND

The original staff report contained the following information on page 1:

“As it relates to the three districts in question, the Garden Valley and Mosquito FPDs were actively studying the effort to consolidate, with Georgetown FPD at one point joining the group before withdrawing. Over the summer, at a community meeting in Mosquito, board members of the Garden Valley and Mosquito FPDs were discussing moving forward in the Fall of 2019. During the week of August 12, 2019, Mosquito FPD notified Garden Valley of postponing action until February 2020 at the earliest.”

This information italicized above is incorrect. The Chair of the Mosquito FPD Board of Directors provided evidence to LAFCO staff that no postponement had occurred during their August meeting. Instead, the Mosquito FPD Board intends to proceed with a vote in October as agreed.

In staff’s estimation, this new information fundamentally changes the dynamic of the discussion and the need for LAFCO to take action as it relates to Garden Valley FPD and Mosquito FPD at this time.
