I successfully chaired the commission through the final stages of the El Dorado Hills incorporation process and participated in the revenue neutrality negotiations. As the public member to El Dorado County LAFCO, I served in numerous committees including ad hoc budget committee and the policy committee which played a major role in establishing bylaws and administrative policies for the commission.</p>
<p>What is your understanding of the roles and responsibilities of the Commission?</p>	<p>LAFCOs are independently funded commissions deriving funding from the county, cities and special districts in equal thirds. LAFCOs derive their powers from the California Cortese-Kraus-Hertzberg Act and are independent regulatory commissions created to control boundaries of cities and special districts. LAFCO's two main purposes are to discourage sprawl and encourage orderly government. LAFCOs have both regulatory and planning powers. LAFCOs use their regulatory and planning powers to control city and special district boundaries. LAFCO's control nine types of boundary changes: annexations, detachments, reincorporation's, dissolutions, formations, incorporations, mergers, consolidations, subsidiary districts and reorganizations. Spheres of influence are key elements in determining boundaries of Governmental agencies. In determining the Spheres of Influence, the commission shall consider present and planned land uses, present and probable need for public facilities and services, present capacity and adequacy of public facilities and existence of social or economic communities of interests. El Dorado County LAFCO often plays a major role in determining where and how services will be provided to local communities. The El Dorado County LAFCO, for example, was the lead agency with respect to the proposed El Dorado Hills incorporation process. The El Dorado County LAFCO determines boundary changes for fire districts and water districts which can have a major affect on services to communities when such a project are brought forward by the district.</p>
<p>Why do you wish to serve on the Commission?</p>	<p>My primary interest in returning to the El Dorado County LAFCO is to support special districts. Planning for water and fire and other services has a major impact on economic development and the quality of life within our communities. I have become very concerned about these services as the economy worsens.</p>






