#### **RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends that the Commission receive the following update on LAFCO-related legislation for the 2019-2020 Legislative Session. No Commission action is requested.

#### **REASON FOR RECOMMENDED ACTION AND BACKGROUND**

The State Legislature reconvened January 7 to begin the first year of the 2019-2020 legislative cycle. At this time, there is no proposed legislation to report on.

#### **CALAFCO 2019 Legislative Priorities**

The CALAFCO Board of Directors met on December 7 to discuss the organization's 2019 legislative priorities. The Board unanimously approved sponsoring two bills, the annual Omnibus bill and a bill that mirrors AB 2258 (Caballero, 2018) trying again to get LAFCO grant funding into the state budget. The Board also supported proceeding with the long-term project of protest provision clean-up.

February 22 is the last day for bills to be introduced.
