NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that the El Dorado Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) will hold a public hearing at 3:30 p.m. or as soon thereafter as possible, on September 23, 2026 in the Board of Supervisors Hearing Room in Building A, El Dorado County Government Center, located at 330 Fair Lane, Placerville, California 95667.

The public hearing scheduled on September 23, 2026 is to consider the following items:

1. Georgetown Divide Public Utility District Annexation of Irrigation Parcels (LAFCO Project No. 2025-03).

The Georgetown Divide Public Utility District (GDPUD) Board of Directors submitted Resolution No. 2025-11 to initiate proceedings to annex 27 parcels into the GDPUD service area for raw water service for irrigation. These parcels either currently receive raw water at outside-District rates, have previously received service, or have expressed interest in service and are able to connect to GDPUD's existing raw water conveyance system. The parcels proposed for annexation are located within GDPUD's sphere of influence, along approximately five miles of GDPUD's raw water ditch in the Georgetown area, extending from the western intersection of Balderston Road and Wentworth Springs Road to Homewood Drive. This project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act under Statutory Exemption §15319.

Unless written opposition to the proposal is received before the conclusion of the Commission proceedings on the proposal, by landowners and registered voters within the affected territory, the Commission intends to waive protest proceedings in accordance with Government Code Section 56663. There is potential for the extension or continuation of any previously authorized charge, fee, assessment, or tax by the local agency in the affected territory.
