Single Family - Tier 1	\$1.25 (1 - 45 CCF)
Single Family - Tier 2	\$1.88 (ABOVE 45 CCF)
Multi Family	\$1.45
Commercial	\$1.37

Example:

Average Single Family Dwelling = 3/4" Meter using 2600 Cubic Feet of Water

Quarterly Base Charge	\$90.00
Consumption Charge: \$1.25 X 26	<u>\$32.50</u>
Total Quarterly Bill	\$122.50

Quarterly bill will vary depending on meter size and actual water consumed.
