Government Code Sections 21024 (Military Service Credit as Public Service) and Section 21027 (Military Service Credit for Retired Persons) are mandated benefits when there are under 100 employees for the contracting agency. Since your agency has 3, these provisions will automatically be included in the contract. There is nothing additional that you will need to do.
