Dear LAFCo Staff: *Due to an unexpected vacancy on the Board, an additional seat is up for election in the Central Region this fall. The nominations forms and this announcement have been updated to reflect the additional vacancy.*

The CALAFCO Board of Directors election will be held at regional caucuses during the annual conference in Monterey on Thursday, October 4th. There are nine seats up for election, two in each region except for the Central Region which will have three seats. Nominations for those seats are now open. Any commissioner or alternate commissioner may serve on the CALAFCO Board. The term is two years, except for the city seat election in the Central Region. Specific seats up for election are listed below. You can download the updated **CALAFCO Board Nomination Package** from the web site. Hard copies were mailed to Executive Officers today. The Nominations Committee would greatly appreciate your assistance in sharing this information with your commissioners and encouraging them to consider running for the Board.

Nominations must be received in the CALAFCO office by Tuesday, September 4th in order to be included in the Nomination Committee report.
