Waiver of Notice and Protest Proceedings

DESCRIPTION

A subcommittee has been working on proposed language to streamline and bring consistency to CKH provisions that describe the circumstances under which notice, public hearing and/or protest proceedings may be waived in the processing of an annexation or a detachment proposal or a reorganization proposal that includes annexations, detachments or the formation of a county service area. The revised proposal, along with annotations on the rationale for the changes is attached.

Because LAFCoS have interpreted these provisions differently, the subcommittee felt the proposed language should be circulated to members for comment prior to submission for legislation. Subcommittee members hope this would qualify as an omnibus item. While the changes may be noncontroversial, there are some substantive changes to the law proposed.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Review proposed language from the subcommittee. Pending feedback from the members, the Committee may want to consider two options:

1. If there are no objections from members submit, language for consideration as an omnibus item.
2. Hold the language for introduction as a separate bill in 2013.
