### **Proposed Fiscal Year 2018-2019 Work Plan**

#### *New Initiatives*

- Train, integrate and support the Assistant Policy Analyst in all aspects to the job.
- Assist Chair Frentzen with her CALAFCO duties, including support in her assignment to the Legislative Committee and Board of Directors.
- Assist CALAFCO with its education efforts on legislation.
- Review, evaluate and update internal work procedures.
- Develop a policy regarding Government Code 56134.
- Update Government Code references in the Commission's Policies and Guidelines.

#### *Work Plan Initiatives from Prior Fiscal Year that are Recommended to Continue*

- Process projects as quickly and timely as possible.
- Prepare one Municipal Service Review/Sphere of Influence Study covering 13 agencies consistent with the Commission's 2013-2021 MSR/SOI project plan.
- Finish any outstanding MSR/SOIs from FY2016-17.
- Provide any assistance, as needed, for the following ongoing discussions:
  - o El Dorado Hills CWD and Rescue FPD
  - o Garden Valley and Mosquito FPDs
- Assist the County as needed on its preparation of environmental documents for the Marble Valley Specific Plan Amendment and the Lime Rock Valley Specific Plan.
- Partner with fire suppression agencies on a multi-year project of annexing islands, resolve issues for lands outside of a district and possibly realign service boundaries to reflect resource deployment.
- Training for staff should continue at all available and low-cost venues as possible.
- Coordinate LAFCO training sessions for new commissioners as time allows.
