NOTICE OF PROTEST HEARING

Notice is hereby given that the El Dorado Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) will hold public Conducting Authority proceedings on the item described below **at 5:30 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as possible, **on April 28, 2021**. Pursuant to the Governor's Executive Order N-29-20 (March 17, 2020), the Commission will hold this meeting by videoconference. El Dorado County Fire Protection District Island Annexation LAFCO Project No. 2020-01

This project was conditionally approved by the Commission at the March 24, 2021 meeting with the adoption of Resolution L-2021-06. The El Dorado County Fire Protection District (EDCFPD) submitted a resolution of application to LAFCO for the annexation of 14 separate "island" areas, including a total of 159 parcels (5,448 acres), in order to extend fire protection and emergency medical services to areas not currently within EDCFPD boundaries. Each of the islands are completely surrounded by EDCFPD boundaries and are within the District's sphere of influence. The islands are located throughout EDCFPD's service area, in Cool, Pilot Hill, Shingle Springs, Placerville, Camino, and Pollock Pines.

The annexation aligns EDCFPD's boundaries more closely with its service area and first response area. Functionally, EDCFPD already extends its emergency services to the affected parcels, but the District does not receive revenue from the out-of-district parcels to offset the cost of services. Any registered voter or landowner within one of the proposed island areas may protest this action. To file a protest on this project, please fill out the protest form on the reverse side of this notice and return it to LAFCO at 550 Main Street, Suite E, Placerville, CA 95667 prior to 5:00 pm on April 27, 2021 if by mail or drop it off in person at the LAFCO Office on 550 Main Street Suite E, Placerville prior to the close of the scheduled Conducting Authority hearing on April 28, 2021.
