RE: Malcolm Dixon Estate Reorganization to the El Dorado Irrigation District and the El Dorado Hills County Water District / LAFCO Project No. 2013-01 (Project)

Dear Jose:

On behalf of Christopher LaBarbera, we are requesting a one-year extension for LAFCO Project No. 2013-01. The extension will extend the Project to March 26, 2019.

According to Government Code 57001, if a certificate of completion is not recorded for a project within one year of Commission approval, the Project shall be terminated unless the Commission grants an extension.

Current Status

We met with EID staff on January 30, 2018 after corresponding over a 2± month period beforehand. EID reported that the Project was at the Mid Pacific Regional office on Cottage Way in Sacramento. This is the last step in the process. Mario Manzo is the Bureau staff member that reviews the Project in that office. A subsequent email (**Exhibit A attached**) that was sent by EID to LAFCO on January 31, 2018 notified LAFCO that the Bureau was projecting that the CCAO approval was a possibility by mid-February 2018.

Reason for Request

The LAFCO meets on February 28, 2018 and on March 28, 2018. Since the Project expires on March 26, 2018 and since the CCAO is not a given by that date it is necessary to have the request on the February 28, 2018 LAFCO Agenda.

Enclosed is a check in the amount of \$649.07 (Ck. 7922 dated 2/2/18) due LAFCO by Chris LaBarbera.

It depends on their tolerance for risk. They can either take another extension to 2019 or they can take a chance that the approval will come in before their last extension expires on March 26, 2018.
