WHEREAS, Carl was a conscientious LAFCO Commissioner, carefully weighing the potential consequences of Commission actions with the public good, and always looking to improve local government efficiency and enhance public service; and

WHEREAS, Carl was an advocate for the Placerville island annexations and fostered discussions at the community and City Council level regarding the potential benefits and impacts of utilizing the expedited legislative process for city island annexations; and

WHEREAS, Carl recurrently served on the Ad Hoc Budget Committee throughout his tenure, regularly balancing the goals of the Commission with the needs of the funding agencies, while leading the Commission to the timely adoption of its budget; and

WHEREAS, during his tenure with the Commission, Carl actively participated in numerous considerations regarding boundary change proposals, sphere of influence determinations, municipal service reviews, and various policy matters; and

WHEREAS, after eight dedicated years as a well-respected LAFCO City Representative, Carl stepped down from his role, in accordance with the end of his LAFCO term, effective December 2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Local Agency Formation Commission, County of El Dorado, State of California, that Carl Hagen is hereby commended for his excellent service to LAFCO and work on behalf of the citizens of El Dorado County.
