RECOMMENDATION

REASON FOR RECOMMENDED ACTION AND BACKGROUND

Per the Government Code, Commissioners should take the oath of office upon being appointed to serve on this agency. The Commission may select a new alternate public member at the June 22 meeting in Agenda Item #8. In order to fulfill this requirement, the incoming Commissioner will need to take the following oath, found in Section 3 of Article 20 of the California Constitution. The oath will be administered by Chair Hidahl.

"I, _____, do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will support and defend the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of the State of California against all enemies, foreign and domestic; that I will bear true faith and allegiance to the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of the State of California; that I take this obligation freely, without any mental reservation or purpose of evasion; and that I will well and faithfully discharge the duties upon which I am about to enter."
