RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the Commission adopt Legislative Process Participation Policies 3.11 into the Commission's Policies and Guidelines, pursuant to direction given at the May 24 LAFCO meeting.

REASON FOR RECOMMENDED ACTION AND BACKGROUND

At the May 24, 2017 LAFCO meeting, the Commission considered local legislative policies to offer guidance to the Commission in evaluating legislation that is brought up during regular meetings, as well as to provide a framework for the Executive Officer when the LAFCO meeting cycle prohibits consideration by the full Commission in order to send a timely position letter. The Commission directed staff to bring back legislative policies for adoption, including a process for delegating authority to the Executive Officer to send legislative position letters in consultation with the Chair when an expedited response is necessary, along with CALAFCO's adopted legislative policies. These policies will be included in the Commission's Policies and Guidelines as Section 3.11, included as Attachment A for reference. The process for expeditious legislative relations is included in Section 3.11.1 and CALAFCO's legislative policies are incorporated, in full, under Section 3.11.2.
