AGENDA ITEM #6: ADMINISTER OATH OF OFFICE

RECOMMENDATION

None. Government Code §1360 requires all officers and officials to take the oath of office before assuming office. This action on this day fulfills that requirement.

REASON FOR RECOMMENDED ACTION AND BACKGROUND

Per the Government Code, Commissioners should take the oath of office upon being appointed to serve on this agency. Commissioner Laine was appointed to LAFCO in February, but she was unable to attend the May meeting. In addition, the special district election ended the week of June 3. The results indicated Commissioner Frentzen was elected to the regular seat and Alan Day, from the El Dorado Irrigation District, was elected to finish out the term for the alternate special district seat. Consequently, Commissioners Day, Laine and Veerkamp should take the oath found in Section 3 of Article 20 of the California Constitution. The oath will be administered by the Chair.

"I, _____, do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will support and defend the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of the State of California against all enemies, foreign and domestic; that I will bear true faith and allegiance to the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of the State of California; that I take this obligation freely, without any mental reservation or purpose of evasion; and that I will well and faithfully discharge the duties upon which I am about to enter."
