- 1) What is your understanding of what LAFCO does?
- 2) Briefly explain why you want to be a LAFCO Commissioner and the ways your background has prepared you for this position.
- 3) What do you think are the biggest challenges facing this Commission?
- 4) Do you serve in any current capacity that would have a potential conflict of interest with being a LAFCO commissioner, and if so, how would you handle that potential conflict?
- 5) Are you familiar with public disclosure laws like the Brown Act and the Public Records Act, and do you understand how these laws impact your actions as a LAFCO Commissioner?
- 6) What is your vision for El Dorado County, as a whole, in the next 5, 10, and 25 years?
- 7) The public member is the sole member of the Commission who is not from a specific public agency like a city or special district. In your opinion, what is the role of the LAFCO public member?
- 8) What do you see as the connection between meeting regional housing goals and limiting urban sprawl?
