The proposed annexation was presented to the District Board of Directors on April 26, 2010 and approved by Resolution No. 2010-021.

The annexation packet was mailed via certified US Mail to the Bureau of Reclamation on May 10, 2010. The Bureau has contacted the District to request copies of the cultural resources reports prepared for the proposed development. Numerous contacts to your office have been made via telephone and email in attempts to obtain the requested reports and provide them to the Bureau. Please be advised that annexation into District boundaries will not be approved by the Bureau without the submission and review of the cultural resources reports.

Additionally, the annexation impact fees for the annexation of the two parcels has not yet been paid to the District.
