

## APPENDIX A - PARK LAND INVENTORY

The District maintains parks and recreation facilities. Its parkland-per-population standards are provided in the 2006 Parks & Recreation Facility Master Plan and are shown in the table below.

The District's overall park standard is 5.0 acres of developed parkland per 1,000 population. In addition to this standard, the District has a combined "other parkland" (open space and special use areas) guideline of 40.5 acres per 1,000 population. Open space includes creek corridors, trails, slope easements, wetlands and other undeveloped natural lands. Special use areas include areas used for field sports, such as archery, fishing, community centers, aquatic centers, sports complexes or skate parks. The District has also set population-based standards for other types of recreational facilities, including baseball diamonds, softball diamonds, tennis courts, soccer fields, swimming pools and community centers.
